## LET'S TALK ABOUT THE SAVINGS CARD

Eligible commercially insured patients may pay as little as \$15 per prescription fill. If their insurance requires a prior authorization, patients can still get Afrezza for \$15/month for up to 4 fills while coverage is being pursued.\*

\*The Afrezza Savings Card provides two offers in one card for eligible commercial patients. Patients will be eligible to participate in one of the available offers at a time, depending on whether their health plan covers Afrezza and/or requires a prior authorization. For the copay offer, a patient may pay as little as \$15 per month. Eligibility criteria, maximum benefit limitations and other restrictions apply. ## LET'S TALK ABOUT HOW TO PROCESS CLAIMS WITH THE SAVINGS CARD

- 1 SUBMIT CLAIM TO PRIMARY THIRD-PARTY PAYER**
  - Afrezza Savings Card needs to be entered prior to running the claim.
  - If you receive the eRX before the patient gives you the card information, you will need to rerun the claim.
  - Ensure that the patient's primary insurance member ID is in the primary field, and the savings card ID is in the secondary field. This is the case whether the patient is commercially insured and covered (OCC = 8) or commercially insured but not covered (OCC = 3).
- 2 IF CLAIM IS APPROVED**
  - Submit balance due to CHANGE HEALTHCARE as a secondary payer Coordination of Benefits (COB) with patient responsibility amount
  - Codes: Use valid Other Coverage Code of 8
  - Patient Responsibility: The patient may pay as little as \$15 per month for a 30-day supply, up to the maximum benefit of the program.
- 3 IF CLAIM IS DENIED**
  - If primary claim shows a managed care restriction (step edit, PA, or NDC block), do not delete the denial, continue the claim adjudication process
    - If you get reject code = 70, 75, or 76, then the patient should be in the Bridge Buy-Down offer (OCC = 3).
  - Submit the balance to CHANGE HEALTHCARE as the secondary payer COB with patient responsibility amount
  - Codes: Bill card as a secondary using valid Other Coverage Code of 3
  - Patient Responsibility: \$15
  - Limits: 4 total fills per NDC

## ORDERING AFREZZA FROM YOUR WHOLESALER

Afrezza is dispensed in monthly packages to meet patients' mealtime needs. Afrezza is available in 4-unit, 8-unit and 12-unit single-dose cartridges of insulin powder, as well as titration packs. The cartridges are color-coded, blue for 4 units, green for 8 units and yellow for 12 units. All packages come with 2 inhalers. ## STORING AND HANDLING AFREZZA<sup>1</sup>

- Store Afrezza in the refrigerator between 2-8°C (36-46°F)
- After removing Afrezza from the refrigerator, it can be stored at room temperature between 15-30°C (59-86°F) for up to 10 days
- Before use, Afrezza should be at room temperature for 10 minutes
- Be sure to inform patients to refrigerate Afrezza**
- Do not** put Afrezza back into the refrigerator after being stored at room temperature
- Inhaler may be refrigerated, but should be at room temperature before use
- After 15 days of use, the inhaler must be discarded and replaced with a new inhaler

### Important Safety Information

#### WARNING: RISK OF ACUTE BRONCHOSPASM IN PATIENTS WITH CHRONIC LUNG DISEASE

- Acute bronchospasm has been observed in patients with asthma and COPD using AFREZZA.
- AFREZZA is contraindicated in patients with chronic lung disease such as asthma or COPD.
- Before initiating AFREZZA, perform a detailed medical history, physical examination, and spirometry (FEV1) to identify potential lung disease in all patients.

**Indications and Usage:** Afrezza (insulin human) Inhalation Powder is a rapid acting inhaled insulin indicated to improve glycemic control in adult patients with diabetes mellitus.

**Limitations of Use:** In patients with type 1 diabetes, must use with a long-acting insulin. Not recommended for the treatment of diabetic ketoacidosis. Not recommended in patients who smoke.

**Contraindications:** During episodes of hypoglycemia. Chronic lung disease, such as asthma, or chronic obstructive pulmonary disease. Hypersensitivity to regular human insulin or any of the AFREZZA excipients

**Warnings and Precautions:** AFREZZA may cause serious side effects that can lead to death, including Acute Bronchospasm, Hypoglycemia, Decline in Pulmonary Function, Lung Cancer, Diabetic Ketoacidosis, Hypersensitivity Reactions, Hypokalemia, and Fluid Retention and Heart Failure with Concomitant Use of Thiazolidinediones (TZDs).
